

Musical Instrument Policy

Please note entry of musical instruments into match venues is restricted by venue entry and ticketing terms and conditions. However, patrons may complete a musical instrument pre-registration form in advance of matches to have their request for the right to bring an instrument into the venue considered. Completed and submitted forms do not constitute automatic approval to bring instruments into venues.

If a patron arrives at venue with an instrument and has not already completed the pre-registration form and received the necessary approval from NZC, then gate staff should consult with NZC event management staff and/or the venue manager for necessary approval.

Anyone seeking to bring a musical instrument into the venue must agree to the following requirements:

- The instrument(s) must not obstruct any seating, path or walk ways, common areas, or the general operation of the venue or the match;
- The instruments(s) or playing of the instrument(s) must not unnecessarily disturb or otherwise impede, harm or disrupt other patrons;
- The instrument(s) must not be used to conceal or otherwise aid in the bringing of any other illegal, prohibited or otherwise restricted items into to the venue;
- The person in possession of the instrument agree to comply and all instructions and requests from event, venue or security staff and volunteers in relation to the use or placement of the instrument(s).

NZC and the venue reserve the right to deny entry to any instrument(s), even where the above conditions are met, where they believe health and safety, security, event delivery or fan enjoyment is at risk. The decision of NZC, venue and event management staff is final.
